IPC events

The IPC is invited to participate as panelists at [the Seventh Anniversary of the Milan Urban Food Pact](#) to be held in Barcelona from the 19 to the 21 October 2021. **The Milan Urban Food Policy Pact is an international agreement of Mayors.** It is a concrete working tool for cities. It is composed by a preamble and a Framework for Action listing 37 recommended actions, clustered in 6 categories. For each recommended action there are specific indicators to monitor progresses in implementing the Pact. The Milan Pact Awards offer concrete examples of the food policies that cities are implementing in each of the 6 Pact categories.

This year is the first time that the IPC is directly invited to participate in this forum. We have been invited to participate in the panel about food policies for the climate action within a process that the **Barcelona City Council built which is called The Barcelona Challenge for Good Food and Climate** that aims at reinforcing food policies for climate action.

After many months, the meeting will be presential and there will be the presence of a representative for the IPC and one representing La Via Campesina. For the IPC there will be Isabel Alvarez from URGENCI, while for La Via Campesina, Morgan will be present. The IPC will be there on the 21st of October.
